



Marine and Environmental Studies Scholarship

Amount: \$5,000

Deadline for application: January 27, 2023

Awarded annually to a full-time student enrolled in the first, second, third, or fourth year of a recognized program related to environment, sustainable development, marine engineering, ocean mapping, natural science or related programs. The candidate must demonstrate a commitment to a career in one of these fields.

Eligibility: Open to Nunavut Inuit enrolled under the Nunavut Agreement. Priority will be given in the following order:

1. Inuit applicants from Sanirajak, Igloolik, Clyde River, Pond Inlet, Arctic Bay
2. Inuit from the Qikiqtani region
3. Inuit from the rest of Nunavut
