Brief description:

Awarded yearly to a full-time student enrolled in the first, second, third, or fourth year of a recognized program in environmental technology, marine engineering, bridge officer training, ocean mapping, nautical science or ocean instrumentation. Candidate must demonstrate a commitment to a career in shipping, fish harvesting, the Canadian Navy, Transport Canada, Parks and Recreation, or Eco-Tourism.

Eligibility:

Open to Nunavut Inuit registered with Nunavut Tunngavik Inc. Priority will be given in the following order:

- 1. Inuit applicants from Mary River impacted communities: Hall Beach, Igloolik, Clyde River, Pond Inlet, Arctic Bay
- 2. Other Qikiqtani Inuit
- 3. Inuit from the rest of Nunavut
